What does it offer? High-quality research training delivered through international and interdisciplinary networks, industrial doctorates or joint doctorates

Who applies? International networks of research organisations from the academic and nonacademic sectors

Who is funded? Researchers at doctoral level (less than four years of full-time research experience and no doctoral degree)

IF Individual Fellowships

What does it offer?

Opportunities to work on personal research projects by moving between countries and possibly sectors to acquire new skills

Who applies?

Individual researchers together with the host organisation

Who is funded? Postdoctoral researchers

RISE Research and Innovation Staff Exchange

What does it offer? The exchange of staff members involved in research and innovation to develop sustainable collaborative projects and the transfer of knowledge

Who applies? International networks of research organisations from the academic and non-academic sectors

Who is funded? Researchers, technical, administrative and managerial staff of any nationality and at all career levels






How to apply? → are you 'post-doc' or 'pre-doc'?







Depends on research experience

Support for 2 categories of researchers:

Early Stage Researcher: Less than 4 years of research experience*, and without a doctoral degree ('pre-doc')

Experienced Researcher: In possession of a doctoral degree or at least 4 years of research experience* ('post-doc')

*counted from the time when the researcher is entitled to embark on a doctoral degree






IF Individual Fellowships



Any Experienced Researcher may submit only one proposal to the call for proposals in any given year

Global Fellowships





For fellows from Europe going to Third countries (12-24 months) and returning (12 months)



IF European Fellowships - Main Features

- Mobility: Applicants must not have resided or carried out their main activity in the country of the host organisation for <u>more than 12</u> <u>months in the 3 years immediately prior to the call deadline</u>
- Duration of projects: 1-2 years
- Focus on **career development**, not necessarily experience
- Open to hosts from both academic and non-academic sectors
- Can include 3 6 months at another organisation anywhere in Europe ("on secondment")
- Separate multidisciplinary panels for Society & Enterprise (€10m earmarked budget), Career Restart, and Reintegration all with the same special mobility rule

Innovative Training Networks (ITN)

- Doctoral-level programme run by an international network of organisations, develops both research and transferable skills
- Training through undertaking personalised, multidisciplinary research projects



Fellowships of **3-36 months** that include time in the **non-academic sector**

ITN Innovative Training Networks

Possible **industrial doctorate** (joint supervision with business) or a **joint doctorate**
