

Number of places and undergraduate courses offered in the last 20 years

In two decades, the availability of places grew 73%, going from 3,802 to 6,575. There was a rise of undergraduate courses from 49 to 92, an increase equivalent to 87%



Research and extension: beyond teaching

espite what many people believe, public universities are not there just to provide education, their responsibility goes beyond issuing degrees. The pillars of public higher education institutions in Brazil can be described in three words: **Teaching, Research and Extension**. Each of these bases is independent, but they are all interconnected and must be treated with the same weight.

Teaching is the best known pillar. Responsible for classes, exams and scores of any graduation course. The goal is to train people capable of exercising not only professional activities, but citizenship. All actions are approved by the Law of *Diretrizes e Bases da Educação*, valid nationally, and by the *Projeto Pedagógico*, which varies depending on the institution. At *UFSC*, Teaching also covers the *Núcleo de Desenvolvimento Infantil*, the *Colégio de Aplicação* and the Basic education programs (kindergarten, elementary and high school).

Another basis of the university tripod is **Research**, which aims to encourage, generate and share knowledge to help and improve the development of society. Everyone can do it: from undergraduate students in Scientific Initiation to professors in academic resear-

ch, through master's and post-graduate doctorates. The idea is to promote innovation in different areas, whether of human sciences, technology or even business incubation by the university.


Last but not least **Extension**, which is a direct link between universities and the community. Law 9394/96 says that higher education must "promote Extension, open to the participation of the population, aiming at the diffusion of achievements and benefits". That means that it is the responsibility of universities to integrate their activities with society. It is because of this important pillar that the community service projects offered by *UFSC* are possible: the school-clinic, the Psychological Service, provision of legal assistance in different areas of practice, among other services. 
